## Gestures upon entering the Church

### Dipping Your Hand in Holy Water

When you come into the church building, what is the first thing you do? Don't, you dip your hand into the holy water and make the sign of the cross? Why do you do that? Well, for three reasons:

- a. in repentance for your sins;
- b. for protection against the Evil One;
- c. to remind you of your baptism.

**a.** Holy water reminds us to be sorry for our sins. When there is the rite of sprinkling in the liturgy during the Easter season means "you will sprinkle or wash". A penitential psalm, Ps 50 states: You will sprinkle me with hyssop and I shall be cleansed: you will wash me, and I shall be made whiter than snow.

**b.** Holy water is a sacramental which is a protection against the snares of the devil. May the presence of the Holy Spirit deign to be with us always, we who implore your mercy.
